NOTE:

THE FOLLOWING ARE REQUIRED BY THE NURSING DEPARTMENT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE PN PROGRAM.

1. A grade of B- or better is mandatory in all science and nursing courses.
2. A GPA of 2.7 or better is required to enter, progress and graduate from the nursing program.
3. The national league of nursing (NLN) pre-admission exam is required to enter the PN program. This exam can only be taken after completing all the pre-clinical requirements. (the examination is only given during the month of October or November.) See Ms. Sharron Willis or Mrs. Dulcie McPhatter-Clayton in the Student Advocacy and Support Services Center, Room B2032 to review exam eligibility.
4. After completion of the NLN a letter must be received from the nursing department inviting student to participate in the interview process.
5. A writing sample based on selected questions is given by the department.
6. A math calculation proficiency test is given by the department.
7. A copy of your transfer transcript must be submitted (if you have attended college prior to MEC). Science courses cannot be more than 5 years old.
8. A signed letter of acceptance must be received from the nursing department (not by SASS Center).
9. Medical coverage and CPR certification are mandatory and due upon acceptance into the PN program.

UPON ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PN PROGRAM:

- 1. You are allowed to fail and repeat only one (1) nursing course with a grade of “C+” or below. When repeating the course, you cannot take other nursing courses while repeating the failed course.**
- 2. Failure of two (2) nursing courses results in dismissal from the nursing program.**
