- c) Institutions in Articulation Agreement may request modification or termination.

Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

The Office of Institutional Assessment and Accountability will provide information periodically.

Procedures for publicizing agreement, college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.

- a) Brochures will be distributed to students who register for relevant degree programs at the Community College.
- b) The College Catalogs of the Community College will contain information regarding transferability of credits to the English B.A. degree program
- c) The Websites of Medgar Evers College and the Community College will publicize the agreement


