

Dear MEC Students

The City University of New York will extend the Spring 2020 Special COVID-19 Flexible Grading Policy (Spring 2020 CR/NC Policy) to the **Fall 2020** term. The Fall 2020 flexible grading policy applies to students enrolled in **most** MEC courses. Under the new flexible grading policy, after final grades are posted by faculty, you can choose to convert the traditional letter grade you earned in **most** courses (any grade from B+ to D-), into a grade of Credit ("CR") **or** F to No Credit ("NC"). Unlike traditional letter grades, which affect your grade point average ("GPA"), grades of Credit or No Credit will not factor into your GPA.

Due to certain licensures and/or department requirements at MEC, students whose major is Nursing, Education or Social Work will not have the CR/NC available to them. Certain pre-requisite courses leading to these majors that are required for pre-Nursing and pre-Education majors, are also excluded from the CR/NC option.
