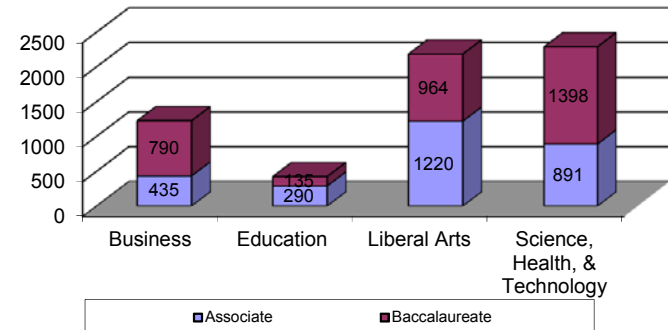

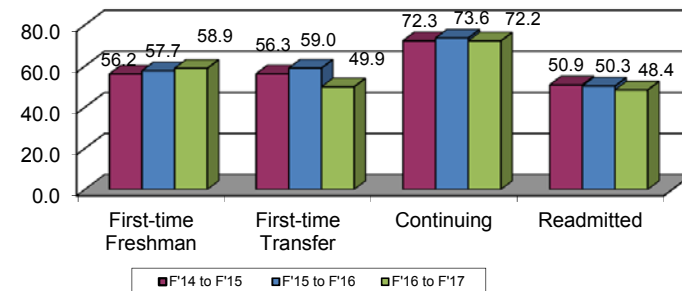

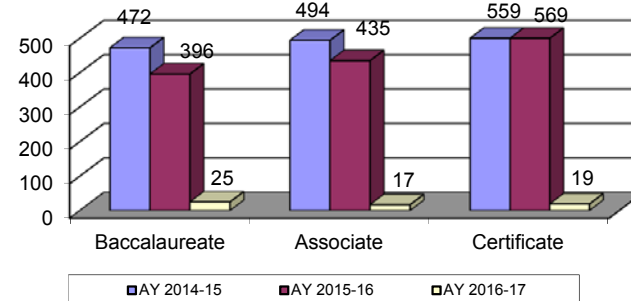
### Fall 2017 Enrollment by School and Major Type
