Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating agreement:

1. All significant changes to the program will be communicated to the receiving College.
2. This agreement may be modified, updated and or terminated by either institution's Chief Academic Officer. Such terminations will take place on sixty (60) days notice or the end of the then current semester, whichever is the soonest date. Any financial impact to the students will be the sole responsibility of the matriculating entity.

Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

The Department Chair and Deputy Chair will review, on a bi-annual basis, the proficiency of the students matriculating into the undergraduate program.



Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:
