#### Dear Friends,

The strategic planning process can be likened to using a GPS when embarking on a journey. While travelers may have a general sense of how to reach their destination, GPS technology provides precise, step-by-step navigation, reducing the likelihood of getting lost. A GPS determines the traveler's current location, calculates the optimal route, and offers an estimated arrival time. If unexpected obstacles arise, the system suggests alternative routes, but the traveler retains the autonomy to accept or decline these recommendations.

Similarly, a strategic plan serves as an institution's navigational tool. Stakeholders assess the institution's position by analyzing its strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. The strategic plan defines the institution's destination by setting clear goals, while the initiatives within the plan function as turn-by-turn directions guiding progress. As with a GPS, a strategic plan must remain dynamic, allowing for adjustments in response to changes in the internal and external environment.

In June 2023, CUNY released its 2023-2030 strategic plan, <u>CUNY Lifting</u>

New York, which prompted a transformation of the CUNY Performance

Management Process (PMP). Although the Medgar Evers College (MEC)

Strategic Planning Committee had initiated work on the MEC strategic plan in Fall 2022, we deliberately realigned our approach to ensure alignment with <u>CUNY Lifting New York.</u>

MEC's 2023-2030 strategic plan provides a structured roadmap for advancing the College's social justice mission, as articulated in the new mission statement. This mission is pursued through Rigorous curricula, Innovative teaching and learning practices, Scholarship, and Experiential Learning (RISE)—a framework that underscores our commitment to academic excellence and student success.

I extend my sincere gratitude to the Strategic Planning Committee for their agility and dedication to adapting the MEC plan to align with the new <u>CUNY</u> <u>plan</u>. GOAL 3: Advance our community through research, assessing existing partnerships, and establishing new ones that are of strategic value to the college and its students.






