Hazing is strictly prohibited and is inconsistent with CUNY policy and the Rules and Regulations for the Maintenance of Public Order Pursuant to Article 129-A of the New York State Education Law (“Henderson Rules”). From July 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026, Medgar Evers College is pleased to report there have been no substantiated allegations of hazing involving student organizations established or recognized by the institution.
