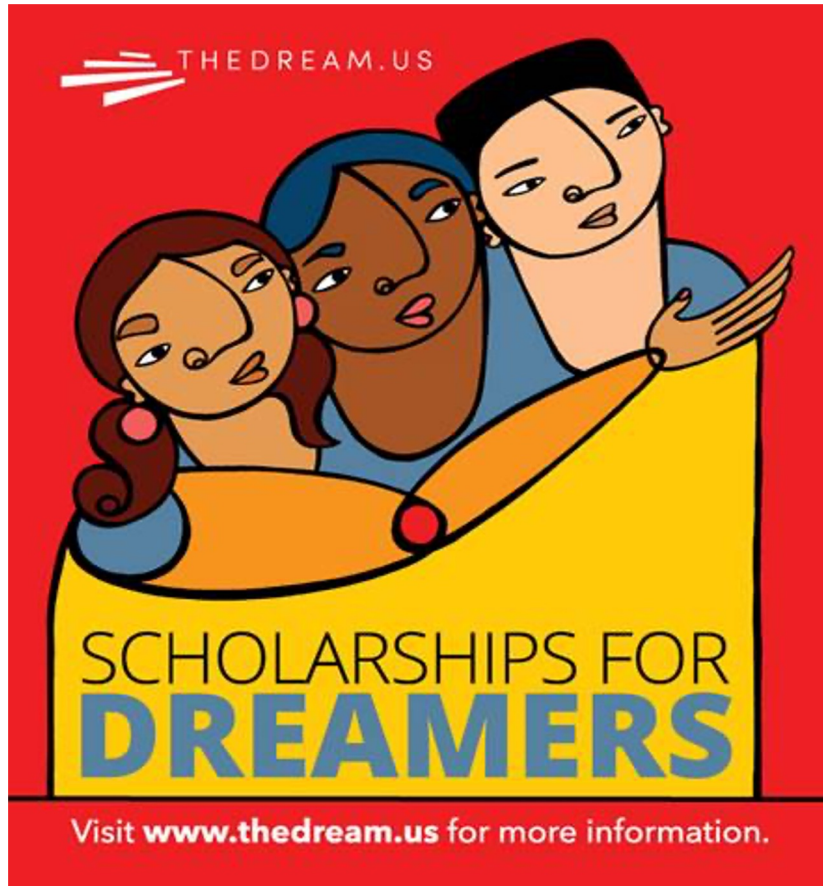

We are open to students with or **without** DACA



You are eligible if . . .

- You are undocumented or have DACA or TPS, and
- You came to the US before you turned 16, and
- You came to the US before November 1, 2017



Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

You are eligible if you meet our immigration criteria and you . . .

- Have significant unmet financial need; and
 - Have graduated or will graduate from a US high school or GED program with a GPA of 2.5 or better
- or
- Are or were enrolled in a college / university with a GPA of 2.5 or better; and
- Eligible for in-state tuition at the Partner College you want to attend (n/a for private PCs)

APPLICATION OVERVIEW – NO ESSAYS!

Applicant Information:

- Personal (no addresses collected)
- Immigration Eligibility

Academic Information:

- Select Partner College
- High School and/or College Information

Financial Information:

- Identify status (dependent/independent)
- Annual Household Income
- Number in the household supported by this income
- Number of dependents supported by this income who will attend college in upcoming academic year

Responsibilities:

- Volunteer
- Community Service
- Home Responsibilities



ONLY TRANSCRIPTS ARE REQUIRED FOR UPLOAD

High School or GED Graduates:

- Official or unofficial high school transcript showing grades and cumulative GPA (or GED certification)

And/or

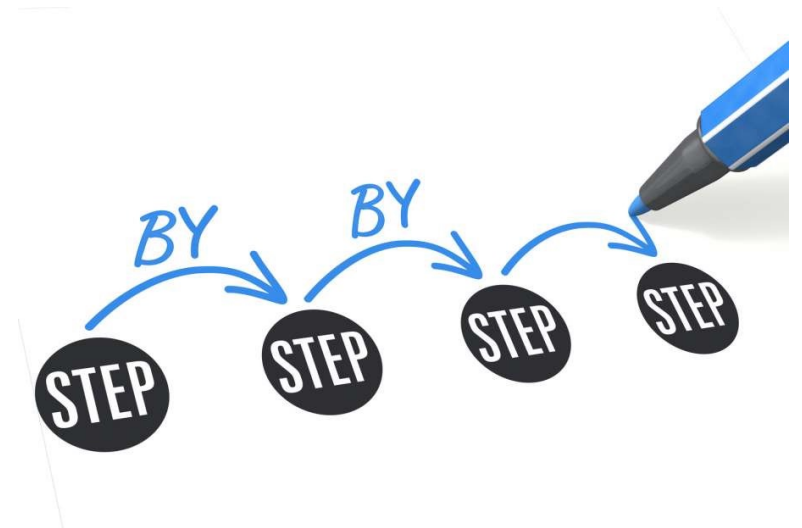
Current College Students:

- Official or unofficial college transcript showing grades and cumulative GPA

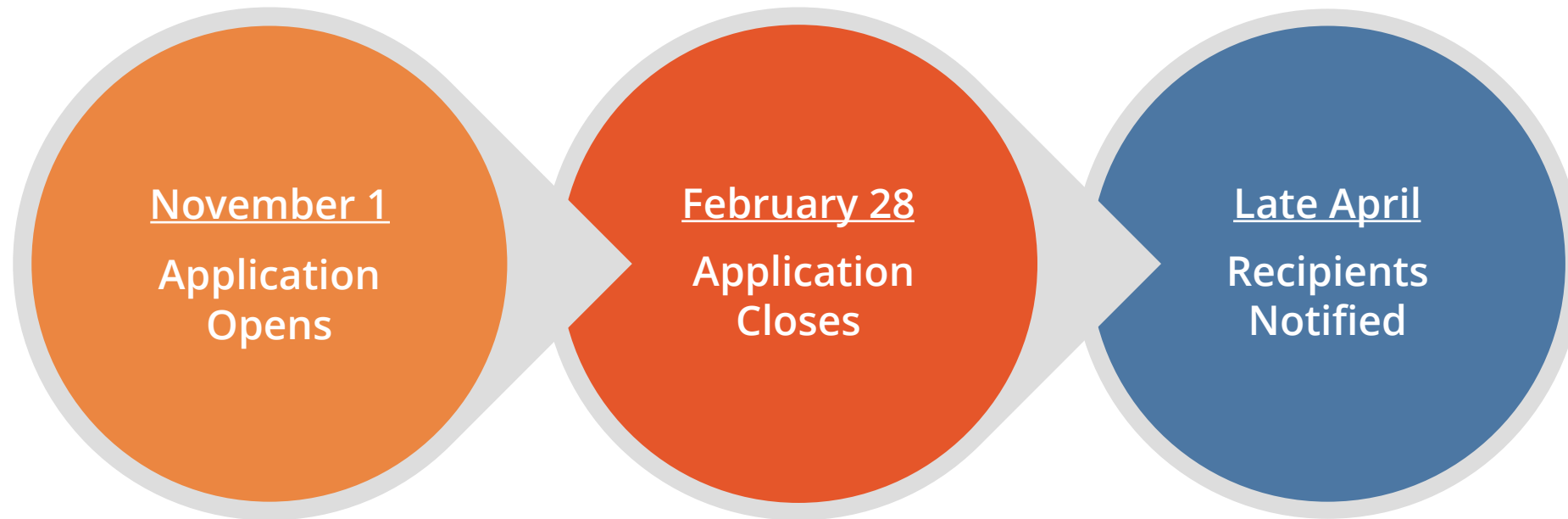
