Joint Certificate with New York Theological Seminary and BA in Religious Studies from Medgar Evers College

Medgar Evers College has developed an articulation agreement with the New York Theological Seminary (NYTS). Upon completion of the Certificate in Ministry and Leadership at NYTS, graduates will transfer to Medgar Evers College and receive 40 credit hours of advanced standing. An additional 80 credit hours of coursework will be required at Medgar Evers College for a Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Religious Studies from the Department of Philosophy and Religion. Incoming NYTS Certificate holders will be evaluated on the CUNY Assessment Tests in Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Candidates requiring remediation will participate in the College's Developmental Education plan.

Upon the award of the BA, students have the option to return to NYTS for a Master's degree and receive up to 12 credit hours of advanced standing in one of the following five programs: (1) Religious Education, (2) Pastoral Care & Counseling, (3) Religious Leadership & Administration, (4) Youth Ministry or (5) Master of Divinity.
