(a) edTPA Performance

Due to COVID-19 pandemic and state closures, no graduating candidates were able to complete the edTPA. They were recommended for the COVID-19 one-year Emergency Certification or the ATSW Safety Net if all other NYSTCE examinations were passed.

In 2021 nine candidates (7 CSE, 2 ECSE) were able to complete the ATSW and gain State Certification. The one CE program completer did not take any exams so the data below will only include information for completers from the CSE and ECSE programs
