ARS MEASURE 8: STUDENT LOAN DEFAULT RATES

Data from the Office of Financial Aid indicate that there is one EPP completer in default from the 2021 cohort. Table 8.1 shows that 42% of 2021 EPP program completers have accessed student loans, a significant increase from previous years. This may be attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic and its aftermath. There is one completer in default status, however considering that student loan repayments were suspended during the COVID-19 pandemic and remain suspended currently, the default status may be rectified. There are no official NSLDS institutional data for 2020 and 2021 as yet.
